Pediatric Trauma Center Study Shows a Reduction in Disaster Triage/Treatment Times

A deterministic population kinetics model predicts adding a pediatric trauma center upon the response to pediatric disaster surge increases the rate of pediatric cohort admission, reduces triage times in half, and decreases treatment times by a third. Available at: <http://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov>
